

DRESS CODE STANDARDS

GIRLS

DRESS UNIFORM:

White oxford shirt (buttondown collar, long or short-sleeved)

Navy jumper (K – 4th) from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast**

Navy skirt (5th – 12th) from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast**

Tie (navy crossover with snap or navy, wine, or plaid from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast**)

White socks (crew, knee, tights, flesh-colored hose, or no socks -- **no ankle socks**)

Dark leather flats (any style, **no sandals**)

Sweater vest, wine-colored, with school monogram (5th – 12th) for 2nd and 3rd quarters from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast**. (Monograms can be done through the school.)

REGULAR UNIFORM:

Shirts:

Navy, cardinal (wine), white, light pink, or gray polo style shirts **from Educational Outfitters**

Shirts bought from other sources must match exactly in color and style those from EO.

From **French Toast** choose only those styles and colors that we have selected for MCA (see list).

White oxford style shirts with button down collars, long or short sleeved

K – 4th can wear the Peter Pan or scalloped collared shirts from **EO** or **FT**.

P. E. uniform shirts should be t-shirts with sleeves and no inappropriate graphics or messages.

Field trip t-shirts for each homeroom group may be ordered each year.

Skirts / Jumpers:

K – 4th: Navy, khaki, or plaid jumpers **from Educational Outfitters or French Toast**

5th – 12th: Navy, khaki, or plaid skirts from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast**.

Skirts and jumpers should be at the top of the knee cap or longer.

The correct plaid is navy, grey, and wine colored.

Only the styles listed for MCA from **French Toast** (see list)

When you buy, please take into account growth during the year so that you will not need to buy again before the end of the year.

Pants, capris, skorts, and shorts:

Navy or khaki **from Educational Outfitters**

Items bought from other sources must match exactly in style and color those from EO.

No back pocket flaps

Only the styles listed for MCA from **French Toast** (see list)

Shorts and skorts should reach at least mid thigh.

When you buy, please take into account growth during the year so that you will not need to buy again before the end of the year.

P.E. shorts should be loose and reach at least mid thigh.

Sweaters / windbreakers:

V- neck sweaters (navy or wine) from **Educational Outfitters or French Toast.**

Navy, white, wine, or gray fleece jackets and windbreakers **from EO or FT**

Cardigans in any of the five shirt colors from **EO or FT**

Items bought from other sources must match exactly the style and colors of sweaters and windbreakers from **EO.**

Items bought from other sources should not have logos or writing on them.

Sweatshirts:

Navy, wine, grey, or pink sweatshirts with school logo can be ordered at the beginning of the year through the school if so desired.

Shoes and belts:

Dark leather dress shoes, any style

White, black, or black and white tennis shoes

Dark leather sandals

1st and 4th quarters with anything except dress uniform

Belts should be solid-colored dark leather w/o decoration.

Socks and tights:

K – 4th Socks can be crew, knee length, or tights in any style in any of the school colors (navy, white, grey, khaki, wine, pink)

5th – 12th may also wear flesh colored hose with skirts.

Anklets may be worn with tennis shoes only.

- 1) Uniforms should be neat, clean, and in good repair.
- 2) Shirts should be worn “tucked in” so that the belt or waistband is visible all the way around.
- 3) Shoes and ties must be tied or fastened.
- 4) Belts are required with shorts and pants that have belt loops.
- 5) Jewelry and all other accessories should not distract or be out of place with the **classic style** of the uniform. Earrings may be worn only in the ears. Piercings of any other body parts should be concealed.
- 6) Hair bows should be the colors of other uniform components (navy, white, grey, khaki, pink, wine)
- 7) **Extremes in hair color or style are not allowed.** The hair should be neatly trimmed, clean, brushed, and should not interfere with vision.

We have read and understand the dress code standards. We understand that any infraction of this code will result in the assignment of dress uniform for a specified time. If dress uniform is required due to an infraction and the student arrives at school inappropriately attired, he may be sent home to change.
